Better Efficiency


- ✓ Avoid and Prevent Traffic Congestion

- ✓ Better Serve Our Transit Dependent Population


Proposed Fixed Route Realignment

Current Parkdale Route







 Will service more store fronts and avoid the Freeway to increase pedestrian safety



Current South 11th Route






- Change service time from 1.15 hours to 1 hour

- Will add 3 additional rounds on Saturdays





- Will add 3 additional rounds on Saturdays




Current Pine Route






- Change service time from 45 minutes to 30 minutes
- Will add 2 additional rounds per day Monday -Saturday to the Pine Route




Current South Park Route





Realign route to reach a portion of W. Cardinal Drive to serve a new Veteran Affairs Office




Current Laurel Route
